

Origin of Birth - What is a belly button?

People in the world have belly buttons, and they are always in the same place on their bodies. Do you know why?

As a baby develops inside the mother, he or she is connected to the mother's placenta by a special tube, called "umbilical cord". Umbilical cord is a lengthy tube with 20 - 60 cm long, and 1 cm diameter. It plays a significant role in sustaining the growth of the fetus by carrying oxygen and nutrients from the mother to the baby. It also carries wastes away from the baby back to the mother, so she can get rid of them.

Shortly after birth, it will be followed by cutting of umbilical cord by the doctor. The clamped umbilical cord is then cleaned, sterilized and covered by a piece of medical gauze. After about a week, the remaining umbilical stump dries and then falls off, leaving a scar that we call belly button. The baby will then start drinking milk and getting rid of waste on his or her own.

Your belly button marks the spot where your umbilical cord was once attached to your mother. The shape of the belly button is unique to everyone. Protect it! Don't pick it! And always keep it clean!




