







Origin of Birth

To find out the secrets of new life, please rearrange the following statements in sequence!

- 1. When a sperm and an ovum are united, they will slowly grow into a fetus.
- 2. About seven days later, the fertilized egg travels and embeds itself in the lining of the uterus and starts to grow. Food and oxygen is carried to the fetus from the placenta, which is formed in mama's uterus.
- 3. Sexual intercourse is a very intimate way that Papa and Mama show their love to each other. Papa puts his penis into Mama's vagina. Papa's penis releases many sperm, which will swim into Mama's vagina.
- 4. Most babies stay inside their mamas' uterus for about 9 months, and come out through mamas' vagina.
- 5. As the fertilized egg divides repeatedly, it travels from the uterine tube towards uterus by the rhythmic waving of tiny, hair-like projections (cilia) in its lining.
- 6. From the vagina, millions of sperm swim up into the uterus and from there to the uterine tubes.
