Course Objectives:

At the completion of the course, participants should be able to:

- Meet the requirement for certified membership of the Hong Kong Association of Sexuality Educators, Researchers & Therapists.
- Meet the requirements for general membership of American Association of Sexuality Educators, Counselors and Therapists (AASECT).
